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Medication-Assisted Treatment Technical Assistance and Coaching Services

1. Site visit
 - a. Meet with team/administrators involved with MAT launch
 - b. Comprehensive Clinic MAT Needs Assessment

 - a. Follow-up on MAT action plan
 - b. Technical support
 - c. Best practices coaching
 - d. Trouble-shooting/problem solving
 - e. Case reviews of challenging patient care
